

DHS Payment Policies God's Garden Early Learning Center

Jackson Christian Early Learning Centers

- 1. Contact DHS to see if your family qualifies. It can take some time to register and receive a response.
- 2. Once you have been approved in the DHS system, DHS will provide you with a Verification Form. You (the parent) must complete your portion of the form and then provide the form to God's Garden so that we can complete our portion of the verification. The form will be returned to you so that you (the parent) can submit the completed form to DHS.
- 3. DHS payments are not guaranteed. Approval is given by DHS for a certain period of time. Approval may or may not begin at the same time that you need child care.
- 4. If the parents /guardians would like to enroll the child in God's Garden Early Learning Center before DHS payments begin, the parent /guardian is responsible to make payment in full to God's Garden during the interim period. Parents may choose to make payments on the 1st of the month or on the 1st and the 15th of the month. Payments are due from you at the beginning of the month (in advance). Payments are collected automatically from your savings or checking account as disclosed in the God's Garden Care Agreement.
- 5. Once DHS payments begin God's Garden Early Learning Center will reimburse any overpaid balance to the parent/guardian, with the understanding that a prepayment toward the next month's care will be deducted first.
- 6. DHS will not cover the entire cost of care through God's Garden. Even if you are granted a 100% DHS payment, be aware that 100% approval will not cover 100% of the cost at God's Garden Early Learning Center. Parents/ guardians are responsible to pay the difference, in advance, between the DHS payment and the full cost of care.
